Abstract Format

Document: No more than one page in length.

Format: 2 cm margins on top and bottom; 2.5 cm margins at both sides, single-spaced.

Paper Title: Provide a short descriptive title of no more than 20 words.

Format: Times New Roman, 14 point font, bold, centered. Do not write heading "Paper Title".

Leave one line space.

Authors' Names: Include first name in full, middle initial and family name in full. Do not include any titles or degrees.

Format: Times New Roman, 12 point font, bold, centered. Do not write heading Authors' Names".

Authors' Affiliations: Affiliations should include city and country, but not street or PIN code. When more than one author is listed, use superscript letters to match authors and affiliations. One affiliation should be given per line, prefixed with relevant superscript letter.

Format: Times New Roman, 11 point font, centered. Leave two lines.

Abstract: In no more than 200 words, summarize what your poster presentation will be about.

Format: Times New Roman, 12 point font, justified on both sides. Do not write heading "Abstract".

Leave two lines.

Corresponding Author: These details will be included in book of abstracts.

Write "Corresponding Author:"

Format: Times New Roman, 12 point font, bold, left justified. Leave one line space. Type name, title, Institution, address, email and mobile no. Each on a new line.
