1. (a). All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Rishikesh (AIIMS Rishikesh) invites the offer in two bid system from reputed, Manufacturers/Authorized Dealers/Importers for Rate Contract & Supply of Reagents& Chemicals and Consumables against the installation of maintenance free equipment at no cost basis for all routine parameters to create and establish 24 hours lab.

(b). AIIMS, Rishikesh shall purchase diagnostic reagents& chemicals or consumables from successful bidder against the installation of maintenance free equipment at no cost basis. Bidder will provide, maintenance free equipment like Fully Auto Biochemistry Analyzer, Haematology Analyzer 3 Part, Haematology Analyzer 5 Part, Blood Gas Analyzer, Fully Automated HPLC, Immunoassay Analyzer, Urine Analyzer, Coagulation Analyzer, Semi Auto Biochemistry Analyzer and ELISA Reader free of cost.

(c). AIIMS, Rishikesh will only pay for cost of reagents& chemical or consumables.

(d). Uptime Guarantee 99.5 % of 365 days including all Govt. & hospital holidays.

(e). AIIMS, Rishikesh shall enter into a rate contract for supply of reagents & consumables for a period of 5 (five) years which may be extendable for another 5 (Five) years depending on performance as per decision of authorities of AIIMS, Rishikesh
2. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

01. Manufacturers or their authorized dealers/Indian subsidiaries/direct importers having a place of business in any of States of India are eligible to participate in this tender.
02. Bidder/manufacturer of equipment offered should be in business of supply of diagnostic reagents& chemicals and consumables for last three calendar years.
03. **Bidder** should have completed at least one or more agreements executed for 24 hour labs services running at Govt. Hospitals or Govt. Medical College(s) or Central/State Govt. Institutes in India. A performance report/certificates must be attached with offer.
04. Bidder should have annual turnover of Rupees Ten Crores (Rs. 10,00,00,000/-) in last three financial years i.e. 2014-15, 2015-16 & 2016-17. For this, bidder has to submit copy of last three years audited balance sheet & profit loss statement and annual turnover certificate duly certified by Chartered Accountant.
05. If the bidder has been blacklisted by All India Institute of Medical Sciences – Rishikesh or blacklisted/debarred by any other State / Central Government's organization shall not be entertained. Bidder has to submit Non Conviction/Non Blacklisting Certificate duly notarized with the technical bid.
06. If any bidder who has withdrawn after participating in any of previous tender of All India Institute of Medical Sciences – Rishikesh are not eligible to participate in this tender.
7. Bidder has to submit copy of Valid Drug License for quoted items which are covered under Drugs & Cosmetics Act.
8. All required parameters of tender enquiry should be quoted by every bidder; otherwise financial bid will be liable to be rejected.
9. In Technical bid, quoted item list (With Make & Model) with certificate of authenticity should be submitted without mentioning price along with certifications and specification as required in Tender document.
10. **Notwithstanding anything stated above, Institute reserves right to assess Bidder's capability and capacity to perform contract satisfactorily before deciding on award of contract, should circumstances warrant such an assessment in overall interest of purchaser.**
11. State of Art Technology offered in the technical bid will be considered for technical evaluation. Financial bids of only those products will be considered whose State of Art Technology meets the requirement or recommended/approved. However, Committee may call for demonstration whose expenses would be borne by the bidder only.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

- i) Eligibility of Bidders:-**This invitation of Bids is open to all reputed foreign/ Indian manufactures or authorized dealers/Indian subsidiaries/direct importers / sole selling agents/ Stockiest authorized by manufacturer to quote on their behalf for this tender.
- ii) Before submitting bid to purchaser, bidder should read and examine all terms, conditions, instructions, checklist etc. contained in tender documents. Failure to provide and/or comply with required information, instructions etc. incorporated in tender document may result in rejection of their bid.**
- iii) Language of Tender:-** tender submitted by bidder and all subsequent correspondence and documents relating to tender exchanged between bidder and purchaser, shall be written in English language, unless otherwise specified in Tender Enquiry. However, language of any printed literature furnished by bidder in connection with its tender may be written in any other language provided same is accompanied by an English translation and, for purposes of interpretation of tender. English translation shall prevail. tender submitted by bidder and all subsequent correspondence and documents relating to tender exchanged between bidder and purchaser, may also be written in Hindi language, provided that same are accompanied by English translation, in which case, for purpose of interpretation of tender etc, English translations shall prevail.
- iv) Eligible Goods and Services: -** All goods and related services to be supplied under contract shall have their origin in India or any other country of origin with which India has not banned trade relations. term “origin” used in this clause means place where goods are mined, grown, produced, or manufactured or from where related services are arranged and supplied.
- v) Amendments in Bid Documents: -** At any point of time prior to deadline for submission of tenders, purchaser may issue amendments, corrigendum etc. for any reason as deemed fit.
- vi) All such amendments will be notified on website of AIIMS, Rishikesh i.e. www.aiimsrishikesh.edu.in. However same will be notified to bidders who have already submitted their tender in writing by registered / speed post or by fax / telex / e-mail, followed by copy of same by registered post**

2. Tendering System

Bids are invited in two bid system i.e. **Part - I & Part II.**

PART - I titled as **TECHNICAL BID** shall contain complete technical specifications and details on competency of bidder and also commercial bid package with terms and conditions of supply, warranty, after sales service etc. (Except Price Bid Form). Apart from documents and signed copy of purchased tender document, necessary enclosures should be submitted in this technical bid. In short,

technical bid should contain all necessary documents to prove technical competency and capability of bidders for supplying biochemistry reagents, kits & consumables as well as supply and installing a trouble free equipment meeting quality standards and technical specification and ability of bidders for providing to satisfaction of tender Inviting Authority and user institution.

PART - II titled as PRICE BID shall contain only 'Price Bid Form' duly filled in prescribed Performa. Price Bid if not submitted in prescribed Performa will not be considered for evaluation and summarily rejected.

3. Bid/Offers, duly filled, shall be submitted in two separate sealed covers separately for **technical and price bids** respectively. Such covers shall be super scribed as **“TECHNICAL BID for Tender No. 24/diagnostic lab/246/2017-Rish(admn) for supply of”**Rate Contract for Supply of Diagnostic Reagents & Chemicals and Consumables against the installation of maintenance free equipment at no cost basis for creation & establishment of 24 hours lab at AIIMS Rishikesh”and **“PRICE BID for Tender No. 24/diagnostic lab/246/2017-Rish(admn)for supply of Reagents/Consumables for State of Art Diagnostic Lab”**as case may be. Both sealed covers shall be enclosed in another sealed (third) bigger cover which should also be super scribed as **“BID for Tender No24/diagnostic lab/246/2017-Rish(admn) for supply of “** Rate Contract for Supply of Diagnostic Reagents & Chemicals and Consumables against the installation of maintenance free equipment at no cost basis for creation & establishment of 24 hours lab at AIIMS Rishikesh”

4. **Scope of Work may increase or decrease depending upon workload.**

5. **Earnest Money Deposit (EMD):**

- a) **Earnest Money Deposit (Refundable)**of Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rs. One Lakh) in form of FD/TD/Demand Draft issued in favour of AIIMS, Rishikesh, drawn on any scheduled bank payable at Rishikesh.
- b) EMD of unsuccessful bidders will be returned to them at earliest after expiry of final bid validity and latest on or before 30th day after award of contract without any interest.
- c) EMD must be submitted in separate sealed envelope and endorsement of same with DD/FD/TD number, date be made with technical bids.
- d) **Non-submission of sufficient EMD** along with Technical Bid shall be one of primary reasons for rejection of offer in first round.
- e) Cheque, Cash payment, Money Order, etc will not be accepted as EMD.
- f) Successful Bidder's EMD will be discharged on furnishing performance security.

6. **Bidder's shall have to submit & arrange serially all required documents in technical bid & price bid as per mentioned in check list of tender documents.**

7. **Tender currencies:** - bidder supplying indigenous or imported goods shall quote only in Indian Rupees..

8. **Tender Prices:** - Offer/Bid will be submitted in the prescribed format only.

9. Charges towards Packing & Forwarding, Inland Transportation, Insurance (local transportation and storage) would be borne by Supplier from ware house to consignee site.

10. **Additional information and instruction on GST:** - If Bidder ask to pay for GST extrait must be specifically stated. In absence of any such stipulation price will be taken inclusive of GST and no claim for same will be entertained later. surface mail or by fax/ telex/cable followed by surface mail. bidders, who agree to extend tender validity, are to extend same without any change or modification of their original tender and they are also to extend validity period of EMD accordingly. A bidder, who may not agree to extend its tender validity after expiry of original validity period EMD furnished by them shall not be forfeited.

11. **Late submission of bid:** - A bid, which is received after specified date and time for receipt of bids will be treated as “late” bid and will be ignored.

12. Scrutiny and Evaluation of Bids:-

- i) Bids will be evaluated on basis of terms & conditions already incorporated in Tender document,.
- ii) Purchaser will examine Bids to determine whether bids are complete or not.
- iii) Bids will be scrutinized to determine whether they are complete and meet essential and important requirements, conditions etc. as prescribed in tender document. Bids, which do not meet basic requirements, are liable to be treated as non – responsive and will be rejected.

13. Non- responsive Bids:- following are some of important aspects, for which a bid shall be declared non – responsive during evaluation and will be ignored:

- a). Bid is unsigned.
- b). Bid validity is shorter than required period.
- c). Required EMD (Amount, validity etc.)
- d). Bidder has quoted for goods manufactured by other manufacturer(s) without required Manufacturer’s Authorization Form.
- e). Poor/ unsatisfactory past performance.
- f). Bidders who stand deregistered/banned/blacklisted by any Govt. Authorities.
- g). Bidder is not eligible as per eligibility criteria.

14. Minor Infirmity/Irregularity/Non-Conformity: If during evaluation, purchaser find any minor informality and/or irregularity and/or non- conformity in a bid, purchaser will convey its observation on such ‘minor’ issues to bidder by registered/speed post/courier/e-mail/fax/telephone etc. asking bidder to respond by a specified date. If bidder does not reply by specified date or gives evasive reply without clarifying point at issue in clear terms, that bid will be liable to be ignored.

15. Discrepancies in Prices:

a). If, in price structure quoted by a bidder, there is discrepancy between unit price and total price (which is obtained by multiplying unit price by quantity), unit price shall prevail and total price corrected accordingly, unless purchaser feels that bidder has made a mistake in placing decimal point in unit price, in which case total price as quoted shall prevail over unit price and unit price corrected accordingly.

16. Contacting Purchaser:

a) From time of submission of bid to time of awarding contract, if a bidder needs to contact purchaser for any reason relating to this tender enquiry and / or its tender, it should do so only in writing.

b) In case a bidder attempts to influence purchaser in purchaser's decision on scrutiny, comparison & evaluation of tenders and awarding contract, tender of bidder shall be liable for rejection in addition to appropriate administrative actions being taken against that bidder, as deemed fit by purchaser.

17 Purchaser's Right to accept any bids without assigning any reason

18. Bid finalization Policy & Procedure/How to decide lowest offer (L1)

Number of tests per day indicated in the scope of work or schedule of requirement will be multiplied by the cost per test of the offered equipment to arrive at lowest offer, some of resultant value will be the offered value.

19) The number of tests per day are purely indicative for the purpose of evaluation and finalization of bids. There is no assurance that such number of tests will be achieved.

- a) Number of tests is only for calculation and finalization of price bid of bidders.
- b) All bidders must quote rate of all tabulated/tendered items, otherwise price bid of bidder will not be considered for evaluation purpose.
- c) So every bidder should quote rate of each tendered item, otherwise financial bid will not be considered and liable to be rejected.
- d) All bidders must highlight cost of each test against name of each test in prescribed format.
- e) All Bidders will have to quote reagent price which include cost of calibrator and control considering control of high, normal/low will run daily and calibrator will run as per requirement (frequency of calibration may be provided, if possible).
- f) But bidders have to provide free of cost including all type of cleaning solution for maintenance of machine, preventive maintenance kit.
- g) Buyer will pay only cost of diagnostic reagents& chemicals and consumables (excluding controls).
- h) In other words, calibrator & controls/spares & accessories are required in routine or preventive maintenance will be provided free of cost by bidder.

- i) Blood collection material will be provided by hospital i.e. Vacutainers, Syringes, tubes, sprit and gauges etc.

20. Notification of Award/Letter of Award (LOA)

- a) Successful bidder, upon receipt of LOA, shall furnish required performance security and submit an agreement in prescribed format within ten days, failing which EMD will forfeited and award will be cancelled.
- b) Notification of Award shall constitute conclusion of Contract.

21. Issue of Contract:

- a) Promptly after notification of award, Purchaser/Consignee will mail contract form duly completed and signed, in duplicate, to successful bidder by registered / speed post or by Hand.
- b) Within twenty one days from date of contract, successful bidder shall return original copy of contract, duly signed and dated, to Purchaser/Consignee by registered / speed post or by Hand.

22. Non-receipt of Performance Security and Contract by Purchaser/Consignee: Failure of successful bidder in providing performance security and / or returning contract copy not duly signed shall make bidder liable for forfeiture of its EMD.

23. Return of EMD: earnest money of successful bidder and unsuccessful bidders will be returned to them without any interest.

24. Corrupt or Fraudulent Practices:

It is required by all concerned namely Consignee/Bidders/Suppliers etc to observe highest standard of ethics during procurement and execution of such contracts. In pursuance of this policy, Purchaser defines, for purposes of this provision, terms set forth below as follows:-

- a) “corrupt practice” means offering, giving, receiving or soliciting of anything of value to influence action of a public official in procurement process or in contract execution; &
- b) “fraudulent practice” means a misrepresentation of facts in order to influence a procurement process or execution of a contract to detriment of Purchaser, and includes collusive practice among Bidders (prior to or after bid submission) designed to establish bid prices at artificial non-competitive levels and to deprive Purchaser of benefits of free and open competition;
- c) will reject a proposal for award if it determines that Bidder recommended for award has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for contract in question;
- d) will declare a firm ineligible, their indefinitely or for a stated period of time, to be awarded a contract by purchaser if it at any time determines that firm has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for, or in executing contract.

25. Bidder might be required to demonstrate system at discretion of institute.

26. Signing of Contract: successful bidder shall execute an agreement for ensuring satisfactory supply, installation, commissioning and support during contract period.

27 Director, AIIMS Rishikesh reserves right to accept or reject any or all tenders without assigning reasons.

28 Director, AIIM Rishikesh reserves right to modify, add or delete any terms & conditions of contract as and when required.

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

1. Assignment

(i) Supplier shall not sublet or assign, either in whole or in part, its contractual duties, responsibilities and obligations to perform contract, except with Purchaser's prior written permission.

2. Performance Security

a) There will be a performance security deposit amounting to **Rs. 20,00,000/-**(20 Lakhs) which shall be submitted by successful bidder within 21 days from date of issuance of "Letter of Award".

b) Contract duly signed and returned to Institute shall be accompanied by a demand Draft or Bank Guarantee in prescribed format.

c) Upon receipt of such contract and performance security, Institute shall issue Supply Orders containing terms and conditions for execution of order.

d) Failure of successful bidder in providing performance security as mentioned above and / or in returning contract copy duly signed in time shall make bidder liable for forfeiture of its EMD.

e) It shall be in any one of forms namely Account Payee Demand Draft or Bank Guarantee issued by a Scheduled bank in India, in prescribed form as provided in this document endorsed in favour of Institute.

f) Institute will release Performance Security without any interest to successful bidder on completion of successful bidder's all contractual obligations including warranty obligations & after receipt of certificates confirming that all contractual obligations have been successfully complied with.

3. Payment: -

i) Payment shall be made subject to recoveries, if any, by way of liquidated damages or any other charges as per terms and conditions of contract in following manner.

Payment shall be made in Indian Rupees as specified in contract in following manner:

i) 100% payment on receipt of 100% of ordered goods in good condition.

ii) Four copies of supplier's invoice showing contract number, goods description, quantity, unit price and total amount;

Part Supply:Part supply can be accepted by Institute but the payment will be made only after 100% supply

4. Pre Installation Requirement: Requirement regarding site/location for installation of equipment, if any, should be mentioned in technical bid.

5. Governing language

contract shall be written in English language. All correspondence and other documents pertaining to contract, which parties exchange, shall also be written accordingly in that language.

6. Penalties for non-performance (for each equipment per test)

A penalty of Rs. 2,000/- (Rs. two thousand) per day will be imposed if breakdown of each equipment is more than 0.5 % of up time guarantee except backup units. Thereafter a penalty of Rs. 2,000/- every three hours.
