Dear Professionals, Welcome to FHSLA Conference 2022

Libraries worldwide are undergoing a significant change and transforming themselves as creative places Offering new approaches to learning, knowledge generation, and sharing as well as dissemination of information.

Libraries are an integrated part of Science and Technology. Academic Institutions, Research and Development organizations, industries, and other institutions known for delivering the latest information are leading this change and are quickly adapting to the new ecosystem.

During the last few years, the higher education sector in India and outside, particularly in the area of Health & Medical Sciences, has significantly transformed. Specific emphasis has been given to improving the quality of teaching, learning, and research productivity. Simultaneously, the focus has also been shifted to innovation, incubation, capacity building, and collaboration between industry and academic Institutions in India.

The Govt. of India, under its Initiative of One India, One Subscription (OIOS), wants to negotiate with the world's biggest scientific publishers to set up nationwide subscriptions rather than many agreements with individual institutions. The success of the 'One India, One Subscription' proposal will depend on whether publishers agree to discounted rates. One of the most prominent scholarly publishers, Elsevier, noted that it looks forward to working with the research community but did not comment on whether they would be willing to negotiate such a deal, while Springer Nature, which publishes Nature, said it is open to discussions but had yet to receive a proposal regarding a country-level subscription.

In order to understand and navigate successfully through these developments and collectively address some of the challenges, the Central Library AIIMS Rishikesh, jointly with FHSLA, has proposed to organize a National Conference on Harnessing the Digital Space: "One India One Subscription" Initiative and Medical Librarians Perspective. The Conference aims to articulate Medical Librarian's perspective and generates inputs for successfully launching the "One Nation, One Subscription initiative" and negotiating with international publishers.

The objective of the Conference

The primary objective of the Conference is to understand how libraries are translating ideas into innovative services of excellence to create value for users and to the continuing success of libraries. It will provide an opportunity to library and information science professionals to share their experiences, ideas, research and knowledge for mutual benefit and also for policy planning for modernization and digitalization of medical libraries cost-effectively and efficiently.

Program Structure of the Conference

The Conference consists of multiple events and activities, including plenary sessions, Panel Discussions, Special lectures, poster presentations, book Exhibition, and Presentation by publishers besides the ceremonial Inaugural and Valedictory session.

Day 1: Registration, Inaugural Session, Keynote Address, Invited Lectures by Eminent Professionals, 3 Sub-themes sessions of paper presentations with Pecha-Kucha format (20 Slides – 20 Seconds per slide), and Poster Presentations. Inauguration of three days parallel Book Exhibition at Level-5.

Day 2: Invited Lectures by Eminent Professionals, Two Theme Sessions of paper presentations with Pecha-Kucha format (20 Slides – 20 Seconds per Slide), Poster Presentations, Workshop sessions on Innovative Practices followed by Valedictory sessions. Book Exhibition at Level-5.

Call for Presentations -

As the Conference will focus on Medical and Allied Health Sciences Libraries, we will have invited talks and expert presentations on the above themes. These talks and presentations will focus on practical aspects and innovative work being carried out, new services introduced, creative research work done, technologies implemented, best practices, and case studies highlighting different aspects of medical libraries. In addition, a few select presentations focusing mainly on practical aspects, best practices, and successful implementation of services will be encouraged. We invite you to submit a brief proposal/abstract on one part of the theme "Harnessing the Digital Space: "One India One Subscription initiative and Medical Librarians Perspective" and any of the Sub-themes of the Conference.

The abstract should be sent in MS word format as a PDF file with the Title, Name of the Author(s), Author affiliation/s, Communication details not exceeding 300 words, and keywords. Professionals whose proposals are selected (Based on their relevance to the Conference, theme, clarity, quality, originality, and timeliness) for Presentation will be requested to submit a full paper and a soft copy of the Presentation slides in MS-PPT. Intimation about the final acceptance of the Presentation and inclusion in the schedule for the Presentation will be communicated individually to the respective presenter(s).

Instructions for Presentation

- All proposals/abstracts submitted should be in English and must be based on the original work carried out by the presenter and have not been published or presented before.
- •The abstract of the Paper/Presentation should not exceed 300 words.
- Each Presentation should be limited to 20 slides.
- Each presenter will be given 10 minutes for Presentation, highlighting the main finding of his/her research.
- Presenters of accepted Presentations must register and attend the Conference.
- Abstracts and PowerPoint presentations will be published on the Conference website.
- If the presentations have any special technical requirements, organizers should be informed well in advance.
- The organizers have planned to publish the conference proceeding in Book form by a reputed publisher.

- Deadline for submitting a Paper proposal/abstract: 1st November 2022.
- Deadline for notifying acceptance of the proposal to the presenter: 10th November 2022.
- Deadline for submission of final PowerPoint slides for Presentation: 15th November 2022.
- Last date of Registration for the Conference: 18th November 2022
- Last date of submission of full-text paper: 20th November 2022.

Proceedings —

Post the Conference, the organizing committee is proposing to bring out, in collaboration with a reputed publisher, the conference proceedings based on the invited talks delivered and those papers, which will be the outcome of the best presentations at the Conference. A panel of experts in the respective areas will review and edit these. Authors of the selected presentations will be approached (post-conference) to submit full papers to the conference proceedings.
