

Department of Nursing Services conducted three-day Induction program for newly joined Nursing officers in four batches:

1<sup>st</sup> batch – from 20/12/2022 to 22/12/2022 = 53 Participants

2<sup>nd</sup> batch – from 26/12/2022 to 28/12/2022 = 53 Participants

3<sup>rd</sup> batch – from 31/01/2023 to 02/02/2023 = 71 Participants

4<sup>th</sup> batch – from 13/02/2023 to 15/02/2023 = 118 Participants
